Answer A. is correct

The Austin-Round Rock MSA will have **3,958,933** residents by 2040.

That's larger than Albania (3,639,453).

Kyrgyzstan (5,431,747) and Kazakhstan (15,399,437) will be larger than our region.

Turkey is an Eurasian country – not part of the former Soviet Republic.

The number of students enrolled in public schools in Central Texas is greater than the entire population of which U.S. city?

Central Texas has 276,125 students in public school districts and charter schools.

As of 2008, the population of

Mayberry was the setting of the Andy Griffith Show – population 1,800.
